The Governor of Punjab is pleased to abolish the Punjab Governance Reforms Commission and further to constitute The Punjab Governance Reforms and Ethics Commission (PGREC) as per the following:-

**1. Preamble**

Punjab Governance Reforms and Ethics Commission (PGREC) will recommend various measures for Governance and Accountability in the State. The Commission shall aim:

- (i) To promote proactive, responsive, accountable and efficient governance at all levels of the Government;
- (ii) To suggest measures to accelerate social and economic development of the State;
- (iii) To focus on citizen centric governance and promote transparency, accountability and corruption-free service delivery of public services to citizens;
- (iv) To promote ethics in Governance

**2. Constitution**

**2.1** The Commission shall be headed by a Chairman, who shall be a retired or serving officer not below the rank of Chief Secretary to the Government of Punjab or a Secretary to the Government of India.

**2.2** The Commission shall have 3 ex-officio members:

- (i) Chief Secretary
- (ii) Additional Chief Secretary/ Administrative Secretary (Governance Reforms)
- (iii) Additional Chief Secretary/ Administrative Secretary (Finance)
